



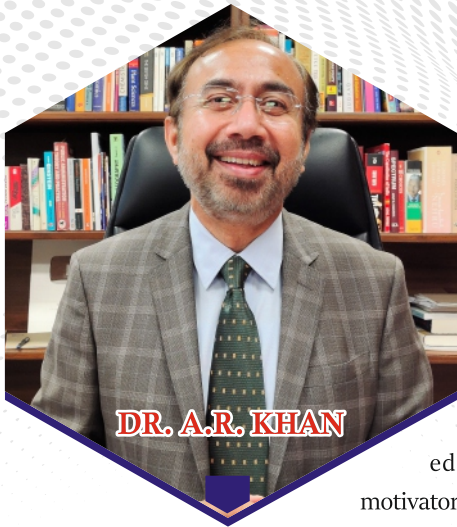

The KSG has tie-up with several nearby hostels. Boys and Girls may choose as per their suitability.

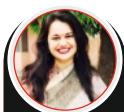

KEY TO ADVANCING YOUR CAREER

THE MOTIVATION

During college and school days students gravitate away from their ultimate career investment as they often don't study those things for which they are basically going to be tested. They may study Engineering, Philosophy, History or Economics, while most of the competitive examinations focus on General Studies. There is no specialised course in Schools or Colleges on General Studies. So, KSG with its vast experience in General Studies and highly specialised team of experts mentored by DR. A.R. Khan has formulated a course



plan that is named **KSG ADVANCE**. The basic objective of this course is to train students to appear in competitive examinations early and therefore it works towards advancing their career. Primarily meant for the students planning to appear in the Civil Services examination conducted by the UPSC, the course may also be opted by students who have been simultaneously preparing for other graduation level competitive examinations. In all these competitive examinations General Studies constitute a substantial portion of the syllabus.

The objective of **KSG ADVANCE COURSE** is to help students simultaneously prepare for competitive examinations during the time of their graduation which gives them an edge over other students who start preparing for General Studies after their graduation.

KSG ADVANCE: AN INTRODUCTION

KSG Advance is specially designed for those students who are pursuing their undergraduate courses or currently are in their earlier levels. Formulated on the line of the General Studies course of the KSG, the KSG Advance is based on the 'Incremental Learning' model. This course would enable the students in utilising their time productively so that learning becomes fun.



KEY FEATURES OF KSG ADVANCE

TEXT BOOKS MODULE

The students of KSG Advance Foundation Course would also be taught NCERT and other school text books in a more comprehensive way attuned to the requirements of the UPSC or other competitive examinations. This will also include imparting them training on effective ways of revision and testing their knowledge gained through these readings.

CURRENT COGNITION

KSG Advance Foundation Course would include a module on current event cognition that is needed to be developed through the newspaper reading. In this regard, those skills and training would be provided that help in effective reading of newspapers geared towards extracting relevant information needed for competitive examinations. Skills pertaining to preparation of notes on current affairs and related issues would also be provided to the students.

PERIODIC PROGRESS

KSG Advance Foundation Course would also include preparing, maintaining, monitoring and evaluating regular Progress Chart of students so that they would actually see for themselves as to how they are progressing towards achieving their goal.

READING HABIT

In this course, KSG will be taking the students through essential readings by familiarising them with an exhaustive list of books which will help them develop their personalities. These would be taught to the students through easy means such as by providing them and explaining to them certain pages and excerpts of certain books such as *The Story of My Experiments With Truth*, the Autobiography of Mahatma Gandhi; *India after Gandhi & Makers of Modern India* by Ramachandra Guha; *Wings of Fire*, an Autobiography of A.P.J. Abdul Kalam; *21 Lessons for the 21st Century* by Yuval Noah Harari, *Rethinking Good Governance* by Vinod Rai, *Good Economics for Hard Times* by Abhijit Banerjee, *The India Way* by S. Jaishankar.

What we are essentially is what we read! Therefore, we shall help students to inculcate a habit of qualitative reading and also teach them how to use this habit to build their personalities. This kind of activity would expose them to a wide range of readings so that they have got some idea of what is known as the 'Discovery of India' and all related things that they might have heard so far only cursorily.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT

This course would also have a module of providing those skills which are very essential for clearing any competitive examination. Such skills would include Spoken Skills, Writing Skills and Aptitude Traits. The students would get specialised help in areas such as the CSAT that figures as the Second Paper of General Studies in Civil Services Preliminary examination. In this regard, special focus would be provided on developing their basic skills of numerical ability and logical reasoning.

INTERACTION WITH SERVING OFFICERS

KSG has got a good reservoir of its alumni who are now officers in different services such as IAS, IPS, IFS and IRS. A key feature of this course includes a plan to introduce our students to these serving officers who would share their experience of preparation for competitive examinations. This would be a regular feature of our course so that our students feel continuously motivated. Such interactions would also help students to see in time where they are moving, towards what kind of jobs they are working, and why they are working for those jobs.



KSG ADVANCE FOUNDATION COURSE (KAFC)

THE COURSE STRUCTURE

KSG Advance Foundation Course (KAFC) will productively engage young students for two hours, five days in a week, initially for the first year of course. In the subsequent nine months, the duration of classes would be increased to three hours and classes would be conducted daily. The course is smartly designed to go for a long period of time so that we are able to give all what is needed for their future career. Also, the classes would be conducted at a convenient time so as not to hamper the timings of their undergraduate classes to the extent possible. And towards this end KSG has designed this course that would go for approx. 21 months.



Catch Them Young!

Earlier, UPSC Civil Services examination required candidates to choose two Optional Subjects apart from General Studies, both of them being of graduation level. This normally worked as a compulsory restriction for students to wait for at least a couple of years after completing their graduation so that they could have graduation level of expertise in their second Optional Subject apart from the one they had been doing as undergraduate level. However, in recent years UPSC has introduced two broad changes. One was the introduction of Civil Services Aptitude Test (CSAT) and the other was removal of one Optional Subject. At KSG, CSAT will be incorporated as part of the training in this course and the students will be taught through a gradual process to develop their aptitude. Developing aptitude being a long and gradual process, starting early would ensure that they hone this skill easily and successfully. The current syllabus also increased the importance of General Studies Papers in Mains examination. Effectively, the whole new syllabus is now geared towards enabling young aspirants to clear the IAS examination early.

A BOON FOR THE CONCERNED PARENTS

The minimum age for appearing in the UPSC examination is 21 years which students normally attain by the time they are in final year of their graduation. If students enter into the job at an early age they get a fantastic chance to prosper in their career and then go to the highest possible level. So, for entering earlier it is important that they begin earlier. Those enrolled in Simple Graduation, Engineering or MBBS courses, which take three to five years to complete, can appear in the Civil Services examination in the final year of their course. In fact, the restructuring of the syllabus of UPSC has been instrumental in ensuring that young candidates may opt for this examination and start their career early in their life. KSG Advance Foundation Course is designed in such a manner that students can advance their career as Civil Servants by a few years.

KAFC helps students in optimally utilising their time in judicious manner during their college days and put them in a better position to prepare for their career after passing out from college. Consequently, they are placed in a very advantageous position like some of KSG students who had done our courses while they were still in the college and they have got fantastic ranks in the Civil Services examination. A little guidance from the concerned parents would help their children realise that starting their preparation early could have the effect of substantially advancing their career.

KSG FOUNDATION COURSE

The KSG Foundation Course is a consolidated one preparing students for the General Studies for both Preliminary and Mains of the UPSC Civil Services examination. For the Preliminary examination, the course covers General Studies (Paper I) as well as the CSAT (Paper II). For the Mains examination, we cover all papers of General Studies (Papers I, II, III and IV) as well as the Essay Part. Once you clear the Preliminary and Mains examinations, then preparation for the Interview/Personality Test is provided through Mock tests at our Delhi Centre. KSG Foundation Course is imparted through Classroom Teaching Method. Classes are conducted three hours daily for seven days a week including on Sundays and runs for 9 months in a year. Key Features of this Course include: Pre-Preparation Plan, Vertical Plan, Answer Writing Practice, Current Issues Writing Practice (CIWP), Proof of Delivery (POD), Flashback Series, My Notes, Current Connect and Performance Charting.

PRE-PREPARATION PLAN

As soon as you register for the KSG Foundation Course, we provide you a Pre-Preparation Plan to begin preparation with the help of study materials provided by us. This Plan would help you understand the Syllabus and the demand of the UPSC examination and familiarise you with the types of questions that are asked in this examination. The course material of the Pre-Preparation Plan includes guidance on Model Answers Writing, Current Affairs Analysis, Weekly Objective Tests and Subjective Tests for each module. This plan is intended towards building a solid foundation for the students before they start their actual preparation.



THE VERTICAL PLAN

When you enter in the class for the first day, we will provide you a Vertical Plan through which you get to know what all tests you have to take each day in terms of Objective Tests or Subjective Tests and their submissions. The Objective Test is conducted on the UPSC pattern with negative markings and Subjective Tests such as Power Writing submissions are oriented towards the Mains examination. The Vertical Plan is geared towards ensuring an effective Retrieval Method and essentially proves that we are planned and organised in minutest details. Such meticulous planning also helps students to know what all they are going to study or what part of the UPSC Syllabus they are going to cover and when they are going to do that.

ANSWER WRITING PRACTICE

We focus a great deal on Answer Writing Practice through KSG's Power Writing submissions that are divided into two parts: Focus Writing and Purpose Writing. In the Focus Writing, selected themes are provided to the students on which they bring their own write-ups but keep separate in their diary the title of their write-ups. These write-ups are provided to the evaluators, who give these write-ups suitable titles according to their respective contents. Similarly, in Purpose Writing, four options are provided such as Discuss, Evaluate, Comment or Highlight and the students have to accordingly write their answers. In the evaluation of Purpose Writing, the evaluator would tell the students whether they have suddenly changed the track in their approach.

KSG FOUNDATION COURSE

PROOF OF DELIVERY (POD)

The Proof of Delivery (POD) is directed towards testing all topics according to the UPSC Syllabus such as History, Polity, Economy and International Relations etc., which are divided into different modules. When the faculty has finished one module, then we test that module. This is called Proof of Delivery. In a sense the students decide through the method of POD whether they have the ability to use the information in an expected format or not.

PERFORMANCE CHARTING

We prepare a graph of the 30 objective type tests that are conducted for the students of the KSG Foundation Course to show their individual strength. This chart provides percentage of marks through which students can compare their individual performance with that of the topper of that test and also performance at all India level. Through this charting students can also assess in which topics they are weak and they can accordingly improve their performances to make themselves strong in a holistic manner. We also focus on Daily Progress Charting.

CURRENT ISSUES WRITING PRACTICE (CIWP)

Within the first few weeks, we start taking the test of Current Issues Writing Practice (CIWP) for three topics, which are covered in the previous weeks. The Research assignments are provided by Dr. Khan and on the basis of these assignments subjective tests are conducted at the respective centres fortnightly.

MY NOTES

We also provide My Notes each fortnight from the newspapers. In My Notes, we also provide material from some news magazines.

THE CURRENT CONNECT

We also provide the students our in-house Monthly Magazine named the “**Current Connect**” which covers the current affairs of the whole month. In this magazine we cover around 100 topics of Current Affairs each month. It is unique in a way that the topics are covered holistically.

FLASHBACK SERIES (CCW, EDITORIALS AND SNAPSHOT)

We also keep our students updated on a regular manner on Current Affairs. As a Flashback Series, we provide the students those news which are old but still relevant and on which it is probable that questions may be asked in the forthcoming UPSC examination. Such news materials are provided to the students on a regular basis. Here, any current issue is explained with respect to their backdrops so that students are able to appreciate their present state. In the **Current Cognitive Web (CCW)**, we cover those topics on which UPSC, rather than asking questions directly, may base questions surrounding those topics or related to those topics. We provide such material after their raw filter. We also provide **Editorials** from those newspapers that students often don't read. Flashback series also includes Snapshot under which we give articles from some of the magazines like Yojana, Kurukshetra & etc.

MAIN EXAMINATION : SYLLABUS

The main Examination is intended to assess the overall intellectual traits and depth of understanding of candidates rather than merely the range of their information and memory.

The nature and standard of questions in the General Studies papers (Paper II to Paper V) will be such that a well-educated person will be able to answer them without any specialized study. The questions will be such as to test a candidate's general awareness of a variety of subjects, which will have relevance for a career in Civil Services. The questions are likely to test the candidate's basic understanding of all relevant issues, and ability to analyze, and take a view on conflicting socio-economic goals, objectives and demands. The candidates must give relevant, meaningful and succinct answers.

The scope of the syllabus for optional subject papers (Paper VI and Paper VII) for the examination is broadly of the honours degree level i.e. a level higher than the bachelors degree and lower than the masters' degree. In the case of Engineering, Medical Science and law, the level corresponds to the bachelors degree. Syllabi of the papers included in the scheme of Civil Services (Main) Examination are given as follows:

QUALIFYING PAPERS ON INDIAN LANGUAGES AND ENGLISH

The aim of the paper is to test the candidates' ability to read and understand serious discursive prose, and to express his ideas clearly and correctly, in English and Indian Language concerned.

- Welfare schemes for vulnerable sections of the population by the Centre and States and the performance of these schemes; mechanisms, laws, institutions and Bodies constituted for the protection and betterment of these vulnerable sections.

- Aptitude and foundational values for Civil Service, integrity, impartiality and non-partisanship, objectivity, dedication to public service, empathy, tolerance and compassion towards the weaker sections.
- Emotional intelligence concepts, and their utilities and application in administration and governance.
- Contributions of moral thinkers and philosophers from India and world.
- Public/Civil service values and Ethics in Public administration: Status and problems; ethical concerns and dilemmas in government and private institutions; laws, rules, regulations and conscience as sources of ethical guidance; accountability and ethical governance; strengthening of ethical and moral values in governance; ethical issues in international relations and funding; corporate governance.
- Probity in Governance: Concept of public service; Philosophical basis of governance and probity; Information sharing and transparency in government, Right to Information, Codes of Ethics, Codes of Conduct, Citizen's Charters, Work culture, Quality of service delivery, Utilization of public funds, challenges of corruption.
- Case Studies on above issues.
